#### **Office Operations**

#### The Executive Director

This time of the year is filled with monitoring Legislative action, working with preparation programs and planning for the next fiscal and school year. My activities since the last Board report included:

#### State partner and stakeholder meetings:

- Gave licensure presentations to new teachers and teacher candidates in:
  - i. Honolulu District
  - ii. Kaimuki Complex
  - iii. Brigham Young University-Hawaii campus
  - iv. University of Hawaii-Manoa
- Held meetings with the following workgroups:
  - i. STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics)
  - ii. Multiple Subject
  - iii. Performance Assessment
  - iv. Alternative Pathways to Licensure
- Attended Representative Ohno's Education Pau Hana education event.
- Met with Representative Ken Ito to answer his questions about Emergency Hires permits and licensure.

#### National partner meetings and conference calls:

• Attended the National Association of State Directors for Teacher Education and Certification (NASDTEC) Ted Andrews Winter Symposium (TAWS) with Chairperson Holck, Budget Personnel and Strategic Planning Vice Chairperson Murashige and Licensing Specialist Simpson. It was a most informative conference,

- especially focused on providing all students with equitable access to accomplished teachers.
- Organized training on the Educational Testing Service (ETS) Praxis Performance
  Assessment for Teachers (PPAT) for Hawaii Educator Preparation Programs (EPP).
  Feedback was positive and Dr. Cathy Owens-Oliver, manager for the PPAT, was most
  helpful in reviewing the process and evidence needed for this new performance
  assessment.

#### HTSB office staff meetings, trainings and vendor meetings:

- Met daily with the Licensing Specialists to review data and operational procedures.
- Met as needed with other HTSB staff.
- Organized training on our new state Office365 webmail for staff.

The Licensing Specialists have been busy with the annual license renewal audit and the forfeited and expired license notifications to Department of Education and Charter School teachers. They have also been collecting data and evaluating their section's work distribution with the intention of streamlining the processes to best meet the needs of our teachers. They will have a detailed report for you at the Budget, Personnel and Strategic Planning Committee meeting.

Your meeting will be Friday, February 26, 2016 in Room 158 at Dole Cannery.

The Teacher Education Committee (Pateman, Mew, DeLong, K. Tom, Lee-Williams, Villalobos, Nakasato, Park Toyama, Holck) will meet at 10:00 am to discuss and take possible action on the following:

- A. An update on performance assessments and Hawaii EPP workgroup during this school year. The EPPs have been working diligently on many different fronts. The last group of program candidates for national accreditation will complete their reviews this semester and we hope at that time all Hawaii EPP will have attained national accreditation. They have also been attending training, both in Hawaii and on the national level, for the Stanford edTPA and the ETS PPAT nationally normed performance assessments. On top of this, they have been working to integrate Hawaii's Educator Evaluation System (EES) and brand new federal guidelines for the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) on top of all of this. In a nutshell, they are in much need of the ability to make some choices in integrating all of these things into their programs at one time. After consultation with the Teacher Education Committee Chairperson we would like to recommend NBI 15-24, below, to you to allow the EPP some latitude in the reshaping of their programs to meet all of these requirements.
- B. **NBI 15-24:** Revision of Educator Preparation Program Requirements for National Accreditation and Nationally Normed Performance Assessments. This NBI gives Hawaii EPP the ability to make a choice on the national, external feedback on their programs, either continuing national accreditation or use of a nationally normed performance assessment with all of their candidates. The dates are set to December 31, 2018, to allow all Hawaii EPP to

attain national accreditation at least for the first time and then allow them the ability to make a choice that best fits their program, candidates and faculty so necessary revisions can be made thoughtfully and thoroughly with the best way to support K-12 students in mind. There will likely be representatives from the Teacher Education Coordinating Committee (TECC) in attendance at the committee meeting.

C. **NBI 15-25:** Consideration of Letter of Intent from Leeward Community College to Plan a Special Education Teacher Education Program. Leeward Community College is asking you to approve their request to develop a PK-12 special education program. We expect LCC representatives to be on hand to answer any questions. A letter of support is also posted from the Department of Education.

The Budget, Personnel and Strategic Planning Committee (N. Tom, Murashige, Nakasato, Teramae, K. Tom, Holck) will meet at 11:00 am to discuss and take possible action on the following:

- A. **NBI 15-26:** Request for Information for Online Licensing System. As the Licensing Specialists and I have been sharing with you we are interested in working with the DOE's Procurement Office in requesting information on a replacement system. This NBI asks you to approve deployment of the best method of requesting information, as will be advised by Procurement, to explore our options.
- **B.** Discussion regarding License and Permit Fees. HTSB has kept the license fee steady at \$48 per year since its inception. We have diligently focused on containing costs while meeting the needs of our teachers and providing outstanding customer service. At this time we hope to substantially upgrade our online licensing system and website to provide seamless access for Hawaii's teachers and ask you to consider a small fee increase to provide that funding. We shall share details at the meeting.
- **C. Personnel Update**. I shall update you overall on HTSB staffing and the Licensing Specialists, who have been tracking data and reviewing operations to identify the best way to operationalize the Licensing Section and meet the needs of our constituents, will be updating you on their plan at the committee meeting.
