TITLE: Halau Wanana Request to Defer Review

Halau Wanana is seeking national accreditation from the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) and needs additional time to conduct the review. The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves a request from Halau Wanana Indigenous Teacher Education Program to defer their review. The Board approves deferral until Spring, 2013 with the following conditions.

- Until new HTSB SATE approval is granted, Halau Wanana will continue the condition set in their previous extension, (NBI 10-55 Revised) and not admit any new candidates to their program until they attain full SATE approval from HTSB.
- Halau Wanana will submit reports to HTSB by January 1, 2012, July 1, 2012, January 1, 2013, and July 1, 2013 on their progress toward TEAC accreditation.
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of initial submission of Inquiry Brief Proposal on or before April 1, 2012.
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of acceptance of an auditable Inquiry Brief Proposal on or before October 1, 2012.
- Halau Wanana must provide verification from TEAC of a scheduled on site review to occur no later than April 1, 2013.
- Halau Wanana must submit evidence of TEAC accreditation no later than October 1, 2013.
- Should the program fail to attain national accreditation by the specified date their provisional approval will lapse;
- Should the program fail to submit any report or verification required above their provisional approval will lapse on the date following the missed deadline.
- HTSB SATE provisional approval is extended to October 1, 2013 on the condition the program meets all other requirements.
