TITLE: Hawai'i Pacific University (HPU) Report Regarding the Status of the Recommendations Required by the State Approved Teacher Education (SATE) Unit and Program Review and Revision of the SATE Approval for HPU

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board accepts the attached report and data from Hawaiii Pacific University required in NBI 08-22 Rev., passed on October 20, 2008:

Full Approval with Conditions, effective January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2015, for the following programs:

- Post-baccalaureate Program in Secondary Education (7-12), leading to licensure in Computer Education, English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Teaching English as a Second Language, and World Languages.
- 2. Master of Education in Secondary Education (7-12), leading to licensure in Computer Education, English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Teaching English as a Second Language, and World Languages.

## Conditions:

Submit a report to the HTSB no later than December 31, 2011 providing evidence that the unit has done the following:

- 1. Review key assessment directions to align with rubrics and analysis.
- 2. Provide sufficient data once collected and fully analyzed, addressing both qualitative and quantitative data.
- 3. Explain and provide evidence that standards related to technology and development of interdisciplinary learning are being addressed.

Upon acceptance of the reports submitted by Hawaii Pacific University, the HTSB grants Full Approval, effective March 2, 2012 through December 31, 2015, for the following programs:

- 1. Post-baccalaureate Program in Secondary Education (7-12), leading to licensure in English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages.
- 2. Master of Education in Secondary Education (7-12), leading to licensure in English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and World Languages.

Since the time of the initial review HPU has closed the Computer Education and Teaching English as a Second Language programs.

The unit shall schedule a continuing program and unit review by a nationally recognized accrediting body for teacher education. A letter shall be sent to the Hawaii Pacific University Teacher Education Program unit head on behalf of the Board to communicate this decision.
