The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following for iTEACHUS, doing business in Hawaii as iTEACHHAWAII, based on the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) accreditation review and decision:

- The unit is granted provisional approval status with conditions effective July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013:
- The Health program is granted provisional approval effective July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013 to recommend teacher candidates for a license in Health K-6, Health 7-12 and Health K-12;
- The Physical Education program is granted provisional approval effective July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013 to recommend teacher candidates for a license in Physical Education K-6, Physical Education 7-12 and Physical Education K-12;
- The Initial Licensure/Post Baccalaureate Program is granted provisional approval effective July 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013 to recommend teacher candidates for a license in English 7-12, Mathematics 7-12, Science 7-12 and World Languages 7-12.

The following conditions must be met by iTEACHUS:

- The unit must comply with all requirements and conditions of their NCATE review and accreditation report and decision, including hosting a site visit addressing all standards no later than Spring 2013;
- The unit and programs must receive accreditation and recognition as required by NCATE for continued accreditation by December 31, 2013;
- Should the unit and programs have their NCATE accreditation and recognition revoked their Hawaii SATEP approval is automatically and simultaneously revoked;
- The unit must submit an annual report to the HTSB in a manner required by the Board.

A letter shall be sent to iTEACHUS on behalf of the Board to communicate this action.
