

TITLE: State Approval of Teacher Education (SATE) Approval iTeach-HAWAII Unit and Programs

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board grants full approval to the iTeach-HAWAII Educator Preparation Program unit and programs effective January 24, 2014 – December 31, 2018. The unit must submit an annual report to the HTSB and obtain continuing national accreditation from an accrediting body recognized by the US Department of Education prior to December 31, 2018. The program may recommend candidates for licensure in:

- Mathematics (6-12)
- Science(6-12)
- World Languages (6-12)
- Physical Education (K-6)
- Physical Education (6-12)
- Physical Education (K-12)
- Health (K-6)
- Health (6-12)
- Health (K-12)
