TITLE: Adoption of Performance Assessments and Implementation Timeline

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves use of the following performance assessments by Hawaii Education Preparation Providers (EPPs):

- The Stanford/Pearson edTPA
- The ETS Praxis Performance Assessment for Teachers (PPAT)

The following timeline for implementation of a performance assessment by Hawaii Education Preparation Providers is amended:

- No later than July 1, 2019, all Hawaii Education Preparation Providers must implement a performance assessment approved by HTSB for all teacher candidates;
- Effective July 1, 2020, candidates must pass a performance assessment approved by HTSB prior to being recommended as a program completer by their Hawaii preparation program;
- Effective immediately, programs may use either performance assessment approved by HTSB as a component to recommend candidates for licensure using alternative routes to licensure adopted by HTSB.

The board delays implementation from the original date of July 1, 2016 because both assessments are not yet deployed and EPPs will not have sufficient time to select and incorporate changes into their programs for the assessment best suited to their candidates.

The Board directs the Executive Director to work with the testing companies and the EPPs to guide implementation of these assessments into the preparation programs, including formation of a Performance Assessment Work Group composed of representatives of the Hawaii EPPs. The Executive Director shall also report to the Board on progress at the June meeting of each year through June 2021.

TITLE: State Approval of the University of Hawai'i-Manoa Educator Preparation Unit and Programs

I am writing to request review of the attached program of study to add the field of Literacy Specialist to an existing teaching license. I have attached the SATE Intent Form and the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board Program Report for Adding A Field To A License: Literacy Specialist. This program is a collaboration between the Department of Curriculum Studies and the Department of Special Education.

The Department of Curriculum Studies is well known for its strong literacy education programs. Curriculum Studies currently offers a Reading K-12 Graduate Certificate to add the field, Reading, to an existing license. Our literacy programs are based on the International Reading Association Standards (2010). Similarly, the Department of Special Education has a strong program, particularly in helping students with dyslexia and other learning challenges. This academic year, the Division has replaced 3 faculty members who have left and are currently starting the search to replace a fourth faculty member. This turnover means that out of the 7 full-time faculty members in the division, 4 are or will be new this year. We are also starting a search to hire a new permanent Dean for the Education Division. We feel that a new Dean will need time to learn about the different teacher preparation programs at Chaminade and prepare for an accreditation visit.

Hawaii Educator Preparation Providers (EPPs) with national accreditation based on legacy reviews by either the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE) or the Teacher Education Accreditation Council (TEAC) which expires on or after January 1, 2018 may be granted a three year extension of their unit and program state approval.

This extension will allow additional time for the Council of Educator Preparation (CAEP) to become recognized by the US Department of Education (DOE) as an accreditor and to clear the anticipated subsequent backlog of EPP reviews by CAEP.

Nothing shall prevent Hawaii EPPs from seeking CAEP accreditation prior to that time once CAEP is recognized by the US DOE.
