The unit must submit an annual report to the HTSB and obtain Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP) continuing national accreditation prior to June 30, 2021.

The approval is based on a Teacher Education Accrediting Council (TEAC) onsite review, their team's recommendation for accreditation, and the CAEP Accreditation Council's decision to award full initial accreditation to expire in October 2020.
