## **TITLE: Formation of Hawaii and National Code of Ethics Work Group**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board (HTSB) approves the formation of a work group to meet during the 2016-2017 school year to review the HTSB Code of Ethics and the Model Code of Ethics for Educators.

- 1. The work group shall be composed of the following representatives:
- Hawaii Department of Education representative recommended by the Superintendent;
- Hawaii State Public Charter School Commission representative recommended by the Chairperson of the SPCSC;
- Teacher preparation faculty recommended by the Chairperson of the Teacher Education Coordinating Committee;
- Hawaii State Teachers Association representative recommended by the President of the HSTA;
- Licensed teachers from the field, recommended by the HSTA. An individual may meet more than one criteria:
  - A licensed teacher actively teaching from each of the following grade levels: elementary, middle level, secondary. If possible, these individuals would hold National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS) certification or have the Teacher Leader designation on their HTSB license;
  - A charter school teacher:
  - A teacher from each county: Kauai, Honolulu, Maui, Hawaii;
- A school principal from each level: elementary, middle and secondary schools, recommended by their Complex Area Superintendent.
- 2. After review of the current HTSB Code of Ethics and the Model Code of Ethics for Educators (MCEE) the work group shall make the following recommendations to the HTSB:
- Adoption, adaptation, or endorsement of the MCEE;
- Revision or replacement the HTSB Code of Ethics;
- Make no changes.
- 3. If the work group recommends any action in 2 above, it shall also recommend:
- Methods for disseminating information to the field and gathering input from all stakeholders:
- Timeline for HTSB consideration.
