

- After the EPP Student Teacher recommended list has • been uploaded, please ask your teacher candidates to complete a Student Teacher Permit application in their HTSB Profile. They will need to upload a valid government issue photo identification and clear the HTSB Professional Fitness Check to complete the process.
- Common Delays in the application process:
 - An individual applies for a teaching field that 0 the EPP is not approved to recommend for licensure.
 - The license field that an individual selects 0 differs from the licensure field recommended by the EPP.
