TITLE: Acceptance of Verification of Teaching Experience and Options for Meeting Standards for License Renewal

Effective immediately, the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following options for verifying successful teaching experience and meeting the Interstate Teacher Assessment and Support Consortium (InTASC) Model Core Teaching Standards for teachers, school counselors, or school librarians. These requirements will be published on the HTSB website.

The following renewal forms may be amended and/or updated by the Executive Director or their designee to reflect the HTSB's license renewal policies:

- HTSB Form RA4010 for all license renewals
- HTSB Form RA5010 (5010T, 5010C, or 5010L respectively) for Teachers, School Counselors, and School Librarians
- HTSB Form RA6010 (6010T, 6010C, or 6010L respectively) for Teachers, School Counselors, and School Librarians

Verification of Teaching Experience

Verification of a minimum of one full year within the last five years of contracted full-time successful teaching experience in a P-12 setting in Hawaii or another U.S. state or U.S. territory is required prior to license renewal application.

A	Hawaii Department of Education (HIDOE) public school teachers, school counselors, and school librarians shall verify successful teaching experience through their HIDOE final evaluation rating.

HIDOE Office of Talent Management (OTM) may submit electronic verification to HTSB that a teacher, school counselor, or school librarian meets the license renewal requirement for successful teaching. Once the electronic reporting is implemented, HIDOE teachers will not be required to submit HTSB's Form RA4010, EX1000, or RA6010 (6010T, 6010C, or 6010L respectively), for license renewal.

"Successfully taught", for the purpose of license renewal, includes:

- a. Verified experience as the teacher of record, school counselor, or school librarian in a public school operated by a recognized accredited local education agency in a U.S. state or U.S. territory.
- b. Verified teaching experience in a public school or non-public school must be approved by a recognized accrediting agency.
 (Accrediting or approval agencies are the State Departments of Education and/or Southern, Middle States, North Central, New English, Northwest, and Western Associations of Schools and Colleges).

Rationale/Background:

RA6010 was outlined in March 4, 2022, NBI 10-56 Revised. This revised NBI identifies the correct form.

Currently, the policies outlined in this New Business Item (NBI) can be found in three different NBIs. Placing all HTSB's renewal requirements into one document allows for better alignment of NBI 10-56 Revised, NBI 17-28, and NBI 12-32 Revised.

TITLE: Acceptance of Alternative Methods of Verification of <u>Teaching</u> Experience for License Renewal

Effective January 1, 2023, the Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves the following two additional options, A and B, for verification of satisfactory successful teaching experience for teachers, school counselors, or school librarians. Verification of a minimum of one full year within the last five years of contracted full time teaching experience in a P-12 setting in Hawaii or another U.S. state or U.S. territory is also required prior to renewal. These requirements will be by published on the HTSB website.

 Hawaii Department of Education (HIDOE) public school teachers, school counselors, and school librarians shall verify successful teaching experience through their HIDOE final evaluation rating.

OR

- Non-HIDOE public-school teachers, school counselors, and school librarians shall verify successful teaching experience using <u>HTSB's forms RA4010/EX1000</u> and RA6010.
- A. Hawaii Non-HI DOE teachers submitting a successful PEP-T evaluation as evidence that they meet the Teacher Performance Standards bearing the signature of the supervisor who conducted the evaluation may use the PEP-T to verify satisfactory experience and will not be required to also submit HTSB Form 4010 Verification of Experience for Renewal, since the PEP-T evaluation verifies satisfactory experience during the five years immediately preceding license renewal.

OR

 Verification of successful teaching experience for teachers, school counselors, or school librarians can be confirmed by completing HTSB's EX 1000 form, RA 5010, and providing HTSB with supporting evidence for each Performance Standard.

HIDOE Office of Human Resources Office of Talent Management (OTM) may submit

electronic verification to HTSB that a teacher, school counselor, or school librarian meets the license renewal requirement for successful teaching. Once the electronic reporting is implemented, HIDOE teachers will not be required to submit HTSB's Form RA4010, EX1000 or RA5010 for license renewal.

"Successfully taught", for the purpose of license renewal, includes:

- a. Verified-administrative, supervisory and/or teaching experience as a teacher, school counselor, or school librarian in a public school operated by a recognized accredited local education agency in a U.S. state or U.S. territory the United States and its possessions; or
- b. Verified-administrative, supervisory and/or teaching experience in a public school or non-public school that is approved by a recognized accrediting agency. ies. (Accrediting or approval agencies are the State Departments of Education and/or Southern, Middle States, North Central, New English, Northwest, and Western Associations of Schools and Colleges); or
- c. Employees of the Hawaii DOE who held a valid Hawaii teaching license during the period of employment for which experience is requested.
- C. The Board directs the Executive Director to develop the reporting format with the Director of Human Resources and report back to the Board at the March 2011 meeting.
- E. Teachers will be notified by publication on the HTSB website and notices will be sent to the Department of Education and Hawaii State Teachers Association of this action by April 30, 2011.
