**TITLE: Consideration of Chaminade University of Honolulu's Request to Offer
Their Existing Early Childhood Education PK-K Licensure Program at the
Bachelor's Level**

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board approves Chaminade University of Honolulu's request to deliver their Early Childhood (PK-K) licensure program at the undergraduate level in their Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education degree program.

There will be no curriculum changes in the major requirements from the existing master's program in Early Childhood Education PK-K. Both degree programs are accredited by the Montessori Accreditation Council for Teacher Education (MACTE), but only the master's program currently leads to Hawaii licensure.

Teacher candidates completing both the undergraduate and master's level programs may be recommended for licensure in the following field:
