- 1. The work group may be composed of the following representatives:
  - Hawaii Department of Education representative(s)
  - Hawaii State Public Charter School Commission representative recommended by the Chairperson of the SPCSC;
  - A State Approved Teacher Education Preparation (SATEP) Faculty
  - Hawaii State Teachers Association representative recommended by the President of the HSTA;
  - Licensed teacher(s) from the field that are online certified or have job embedded online teaching experience
  - A HIDOE or Hawaii Charter School principal/director that have an online program
- 2. The work group will revisit NBI 13-33 and the work group shall make the following recommendations to the HTSB:
  - Revision or replacement the current Online Teaching licensure requirements; or
  - Make no changes.
- 3. If the work group recommends any action, it shall also recommend:
  - Methods for disseminating information to the field and gathering input from all stakeholders;
