TITLE: Formation of the 2022-2023 Career and Technical Education Workgroup

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board (HTSB) approves the formation of a workgroup to meet during the 2022-2023 school year to review the HTSB's Career and Technical Education (CTE) criteria for licensure.

- 1. The workgroup may be composed of the following representatives:
 - Hawaii Department of Education representative(s)
 - State CTE office
 - Hawaii State Public Charter School Commission representative recommended by the Chairperson of the SPCSC
 - A State Approved Teacher Education Preparation (SATEP) Faculty member
 - Hawaii State Teachers Association representative recommended by the President of the HSTA
 - Licensed teacher(s) from the field that are licensed or have job embedded teaching experience in CTE
 - A HIDOE and/or Hawaii Charter School principal/director that have a CTE program
- 2. The workgroup will revisit <u>NBI 09-41 Revised</u>, and the workgroup shall make the following recommendations to the HTSB:
 - Revision or replacement of the current CTE licensure requirements or
 - Make no changes.
- 3. If the workgroup recommends any action, it shall also recommend:
 - Methods for disseminating information to the field and gathering input from all stakeholders.
