Rationale/Background:

Initiated in January 2023 under the leadership of Lieutenant Governor Sylvia Luke, Ready Keiki is committed to providing preschool access for all 3- and 4-year-olds in Hawai'i by 2032, with a target of creating over 400 classrooms statewide.

As the number of public preschool classrooms increases, HTSB will need to develop and authorize approved HTSB educator preparation providers to address the counseling needs of these students.

Expanding the school counseling license to encompass preschool levels would allow counselors to assist a broader spectrum of students, enhancing the adaptability and effectiveness of the education system for both educators and young learners.
