TITLE: Case 24-03

This case has been brought to the attention of the Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board ("HTSB") in this executive meeting to discuss the appropriate action to take on NBI 24-16; Case No. 24-03 pursuant to Hawaii Revised Statutes §92-5(a)(1), regarding this educator's teaching license.

In Case No. 24-03, the educator was terminated from employment with a Hawai'i Public Charter School ("PCS") on August 19, 2021, due to noncompliance after a course of more than a year with established procedures for attendance and leaves, and attention to deadlines. The educator currently has an active Hawai'i Standard License. The educator failed to report her termination from employment as is required under Hawaii Administrative Rules ("HAR") §8-54-9.16(c)(1).

The HTSB adopts the recommendations of the Executive Director in consideration of Case No. 24-03, which is to take appropriate disciplinary action on the educator's Hawai'i Standard Teaching License.
