

TITLE: Approval of the K-6 Music Education Program at the University of Hawaii-Manoa

The Hawaii Teacher Standards Board grants full state approval status to the K-6 Music Education Program at the University of Hawaii- Manoa, effective March 3, 2003. The continuing review shall be conducted through the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE).

The Board takes this action because:

- a. The current Music Education Program has state approval status for K-12 and 7-12 levels. Because an increasing number of teacher candidates expressed the desire to focus upon music education at the elementary level, the need for this additional developmental level was requested.
- b. The proposed program is approved by the National Music Education Specialty Association. Because this national approval is accepted by NCATE, HTSB- under its partnership agreement with NCATE- awards this full Hawaii state approval status.
