

Standard License

Revised 01/2025

A Standard License may be issued to teachers who have completed a state-approved teacher education program (SATEP) and taught **three or more years** of full-time teaching experience within the last five years in a P-12 contracted position from a school in Hawai'i or another U.S. state. This license is a NASDTEC Stage 3 License. A Standard License is valid for five years and expires on June 30th. This license is renewable.

🖓 Useful Tips 💡

If you are locked out of your HTSB account, email htsb@hawaii.gov for assistance. DO NOT create a new account.

- → Check the *Contact HTSB* tab of your account for communication from HTSB licensing specialists and staff.
- → Update your HTSB Profile: Name, Address, and Phone.
- → Use a current <u>personal</u> email address (e.g., Gmail, Yahoo, Hotmail, iCloud) as the primary in the *Email* tab of your account. School or higher education email addresses are *not* acceptable.
- → Submit clear and readable copies of your documents to the *Documents* tab of your account. <u>Click here</u> for a guide on how to upload documents.
- → Information on your valid government-issued photo identification must match the Profile information in your account and all submitted documents. Further documentation may be required if needed.
- → All HTSB Forms require wet/ink or digitally stamped signatures. The most updated versions of HTSB Forms are located on the HTSB website > *Licensing and Permits* > <u>HTSB Forms</u>. Outdated versions and incomplete forms are *not* acceptable.

****Important Note**

The application review process may take up to six (6) weeks pending receipt of required documents. All applications will be processed in the order they are received. Go to your HTSB account's *My Profile Home* and check *My HTSB Transaction History* for the status of your application.

Requirements for a Standard License

- Clear the Hawai'i Teacher Standards Board (HTSB) Professional Fitness check.
- Copy of your signed U.S. Social Security Card.
- Copy of your valid government-issued photo identification (submit one):
 - A valid U.S. passport or passport card
 - A valid international passport or passport card
 - A valid driver's license issued by any U.S. state
 - A valid identification card issued by any U.S. state
 - A valid U.S. military or military dependent identification card (including the back side)
 - A valid U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner identification card
 - A Native American Tribal Document
 - A valid U.S. Visa
 - A valid U.S. Green Card

**Note: A school identification will <u>not</u> be accepted.

Completed a state-approved teacher education program.

Verify three years out of the last five years of full-time teaching experience in a P-12 contracted position from a school in Hawai'i or another U.S. state. *Submit HTSB Form EX1000.*

Copy of your official transcript of a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution or the equivalent from a non-U.S. institution.

Choose ONE of options A through E below for the remaining requirements:

Option A: Hawaiʻi Approved SATEP	Complete a Hawai'i-approved teacher, librarian or counselor SATEP. The Hawai'i SATEP will send a recommendation to HTSB.
Option B: Other U.S. Approved SATEP	 Receive satisfactory completion of a teacher, librarian or counselor SATEP in the U.S. <i>Submit HTSB Form LA3009.</i> Pass the following licensure tests identified in <i>NBI 21-13</i>: Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics Praxis Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) for recommended grade level(s) Praxis content test(s)
Option C: Out-of-State Valid License Holders (Reciprocity)	 Possess a valid unrevoked standard or equivalent, teaching license from another state issued for the first time on or after July 1, 2006. <i>Submit HTSB Form OS3009.</i> Submit a copy of your valid U.S. teaching license. Verification of satisfactory completion of a teacher, librarian, or counselor SATEP in the U.S. may be requested. <i>Submit HTSB Form LA3009.</i> **Note: Issued for the first time prior to 2006 requires basic skills and content knowledge verification.
Option D: National Board Certified Teacher	Hold a valid National Board Certification in the license field. <i>Submit a copy of your official letter.</i>
Option E: Performance Assessment	 Pass a board-approved performance assessment normed for Hawai'i in combination with any other requirements determined by a Hawai'i preparation program to be recommended for licensure by the program. The Hawai'i SATEP will send a recommendation to HTSB. Meet basic skills and content knowledge requirements. Additional information may be requested.
Option F: Did Not Renew Standard License Before Due Date	 My license did not expire more than two years ago. I can provide a copy of a teacher evaluation completed within the past five years. I can verify at least one full year within the last five years of successful full-time teaching experience in a P-12 accredited setting in Hawai'i, the U.S., or a U.S. jurisdiction.

Option G: Did Not Renew Standard License Before Due Date	My license did not expire more than two years ago. I can provide evidence of each HTSB Teacher Performance Standard. I can verify at least one full year within the last five years of successful full- time teaching experience in a P-12 accredited setting in Hawai'i, the U.S., or a U.S. jurisdiction.
Option H: Resigned or Retired	My license did not expire more than two years ago. I can provide a copy of a teacher evaluation completed within the past five years. I can verify at least one full year within the last five years of successful full- time teaching experience in a P-12 accredited setting in Hawai'i, the U.S., or a U.S. jurisdiction.

Maintenance for a Standard License

Apply to renew your Standard License as early as <u>January 1st</u> of the year that it expires.
