### Hawaii State Law

§302A-805 "No person shall serve as a half-time or full-time teacher in a public school without first having obtained a license or permit from the board under this subpart."

§8-54-3 Definitions: "[Teacher] shall include but not be limited to classroom teachers, school librarians, counselors, registrars, and special education teachers."

Standard	<ul> <li>A NASDTEC Stage 3 License</li> <li>Three years or more of full-time teaching experience within the last five years in a P-12 setting in Hawai'i or another U.S. State.</li> </ul>	5 years renewable
<ul><li>Standard Limited</li><li>CTE</li><li>Computer Science</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Restricts teaching to the field on the license, and additional fields may not be added.</li> <li>Three years of industry experience in the license field are required.</li> <li>May not teach other subjects and may only add other limited CTE fields.</li> </ul>	<ul><li>Valid for five (5) years</li><li>Renewable</li></ul>
Advanced	<ul> <li>A NASDTEC Stage 4 License</li> <li>Five years or more of full-time teaching experience within the last eight years in a P-I2 setting in Hawai'i or another U.S. State.</li> </ul>	10 years renewable

HTSB Permits	Description	Duration (July I – June 30)
Student Teacher	<ul> <li>Issued to an unlicensed individual recommended by a Hawai'i SATEP to serve as a student-teacher.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Valid for one year limited duty.</li> <li>May be renewed as many times as a preparation program recommends the individual</li> </ul>
Emergency Hire	<ul> <li>Issued to an unlicensed individual employed by a Hawai'i Department of Education (HIDOE) or Hawai'i State Public Charter School (HIPCS)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Valid for one year</li> <li>May be reissued twice for a maximum of three years while working to obtain a license</li> </ul>
Hawaiian	<ul> <li>Issued to an unlicensed individual HIDOE or HIPCS in Kaia'ōlelo-Kaiapuni Hawai'i, Hawaiian Language Immersion, or Hawaiian Knowledge classrooms when no licensed teacher is available.</li> <li>Recommended by the Office of Hawaiian Education (OHE).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>One year</li> <li>May be reissued four times for one term of five years.</li> <li>A second term of five years may be renewed once, valid for one year at a time. (§ 8-54-9.6.a, 2019)</li> </ul>
Career and Technical Education	<ul> <li>Issued to an unlicensed individual employed by a HIDOE or HIPCS in a CTE classroom when no licensed teacher is available.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Valid for five years</li> <li>May be renewed once for another five years. (§ 8-54-9.6.b, 2019</li> </ul>

  - School Librarian


